SIGHTSEEING TOUR, SUNDAY, 8 DEC

A sightseeing trip has been arranged to the University and City of Oxford, on Sunday, 8 Dec. A number of the Colleges will be visited as well as other points of interest.

The party which will consist of 100 personnel of this battalion, will leave the transport lines at 0900 hrs. An officer will be in charge. Those taking part will be excused Church parade. They will return before 2100 hrs.

A hot meal will be provided at noon, which will be served in Rhodes House, South Parks Road, OXFORD, at 1130 hrs. The party will be met there by ten guides, and each guide will take a group of men. An evening meal will also be provided.

Dress:- Battle dress, balmoral, great coat, respirator, and steel helmet; mess tin, knife fork and spoon with cup in small haversack, slung.

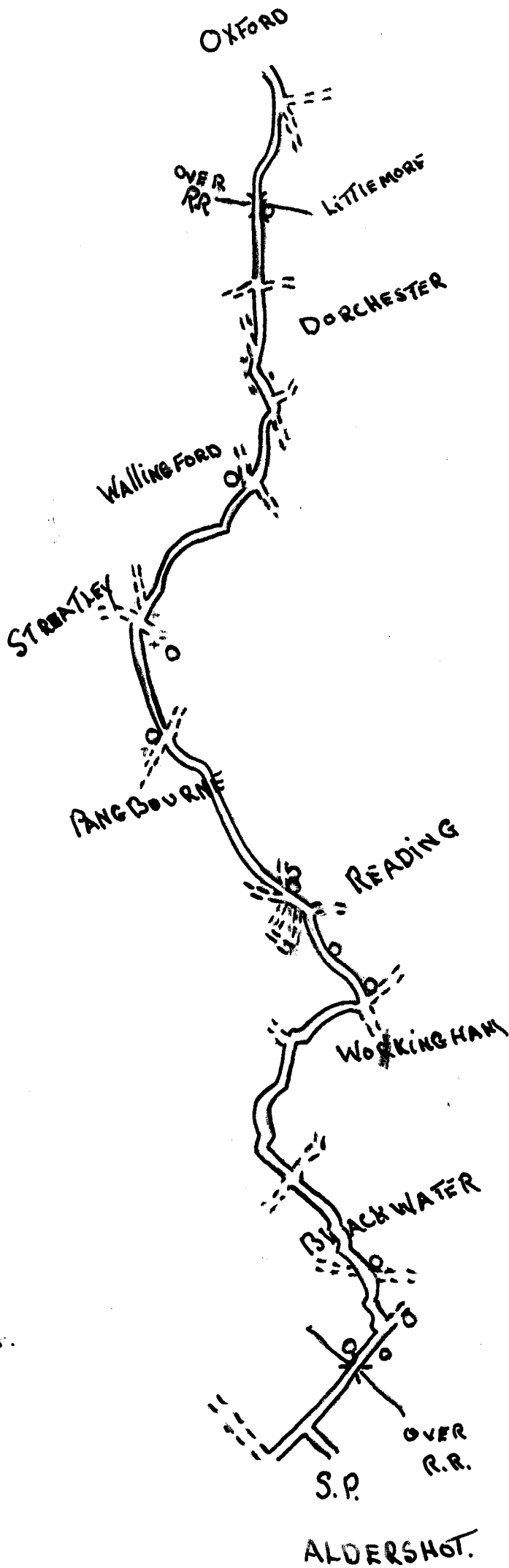
Names of personnel who wish to avail themselves of this trip are to be handed in to the Orderly Room not later than 1400 hours Friday, 6 Dec. 40.
