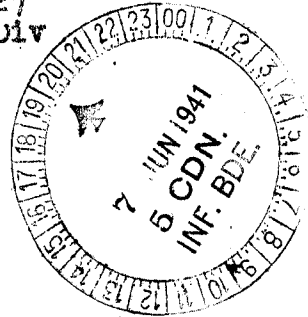

SPECIAL IDEA. (GERMAN)

During early June the Germans occupied LONRAQ without any resistance on the part of the population.

One Corps only was left in occupation and was located as the Canadian Corps is at the present time. Two bombing sqns are in support.

The British are known to have increased their troops in their mandated territory of WESSEX. From agents reports the strength of the British force was not estimated to exceed one Corps.

The German Corps Comd has been ordered to prepare plans to seize the WORTHY DOWN oilfields; Re-adjustments in location to assemble troops nearer the frontier may be made, but in carrying these out due consideration must be given to the requirements of secrecy. No movement across the frontier will be made until further instructions are received from the German High Command.

It is essential that when the order to advance is received troops should be put in movement with a minimum of delay.

The inhabitants of WINRAN are entirely passive and are unlikely to take any action at all if either side enters their country. It is believed however that the British would have no hesitation in entering WINRAN to prevent the oilfields falling into enemy hands.

Required:- The following information will be forwarded to reach this H.C. by 9 June:-

- (a) Tracing showing proposed dispositions of troops in preparation for advance across the frontier.
- (b) Plan for advance and seizure of oilfields.

OPENING NARRATIVE (Both Sides)

The area HAMPSHIRE, WILTSHIRE and SOUTH BERKSHIRE represent a portion of the Middle East. The Germans have occupied the country of LONRAQ to the East whose western frontier is the rd LONDON - CAMBERLEY Q 37 - FARNHAM Q 26 - FETERSFIELD Q 14 - PORTSMOUTH Q 02,

The British have concentrated troops in their mandated territory of WESSEX; the eastern frontier of which is the R. AVON.

Between these two counties lies the small neutral state of WINRAN whose importance lies in the rich WORTHY DOWN U 85 oilfields in the area SUTTON SCOTNEY U 85 - KINGSWORTHY U 95 - STOCKBRIDGE U 75 - CHILBOLTON U 85.

To the North of this coastal strip lies THAMESKEY a large neutral country whose frontier lies along the rd FROME U 26 - AMESBURY U 56 - ANDOVER U 86 - BASINGSTOKE Q 07 - CAMBERLEY.

It is vital to the interests of both BRITAIN and GERMANY not to alienate this country by violating the frontier.

It is essential to both sides that the WORTHY DOWN oilfields do not fall into the hands of the enemy.

The inhabitants of WESSEX, WINRAN and LONRAQ are quite apathetic to any strangers entering their country and can be relied on not to offer any resistance.

4. Umpires will be required on all day Recce, 24 Jun. Details of this will be given at conference on 23 Jun 41.



- (d) Repair Party - R.C.E. 2 Cdn Div are organizing a small repair det to remain on call during exercise to move at 1 hrs notice to scene of reported damage.

7. Medical -

Actual casualties during exercise will be reported, by fastest means possible, to H.Q. 5 Cdn Inf Bde, who will arrange evacuation as circumstances require.


