2. Tpt as previously stated will report to A & D Coys at 2208000A.
3. Party of 1 NCO and 3 OR s for "A" Coy is cancelled.
4. "A" Coy will be responsible to collect LIFEBOOYS from B & C Coys and bring these with them to Trg Area and to ensure that they are returned on completion of Trg. "D" Coy will bring own LIFEBOOYS.
4. T.O. will have 1 60 cwt report to Sp coy at 230630A. Sp will detail 1 NCO and 3 men to proceed with this 60 cwt to HQ 5 CIB and report to Lt Falardeau. Sp Coy will be responsible to ensure that NCO knows route and that party arrives at Bde H.Q. not later than 230730A.
