

The 2 PW went through 3 Div sector and were captured by our Standing Patrol as they were going to their posn at 766558. Their morale is pretty low because their meals are poor, and everything is going wrong in their case. They were captured around 760561. One is Fr (Alsace Lorraine) and the other is pure German. Both belong to 328 Bn Gren Ersatz according to their Soldbuch. They were coming from wood 767563 and they claimed that they are always sending patrol from there. According to them 90% want to surrender but they are held back by threats of retaliation on their families.

Identification: 2 Coy (I Bn) 1051 GR. 1 and 2 Coys being relieved night 27/28 via ELSENHOFF. Possibly at 2300 hrs. 2 Coy at 783556 between orchard and rly track.
